Refer a Co-Worker

During 2023 we invite you to refer a co-worker of the city and have your name entered into a drawing for a \$100.00 deposit into your account with us.

Drawings are done the first month of every quarter.

Be Safe and smart when you travel

Here are a few practical tips to help you avoid bumps in your road trips or overseas vacations.

- Scan your passport, tickets, itinerary, and other documents to yourself and friends. If the originals are lost or stolen, just log in to your email account.
- If you are a member of the AAA or similar group, check to see what travel benefits they offer, such as trip planning, airfare/ hotel discounts, auto rental discount, emergency assistance, international driver's license/ insurance, and maps/guides.
- Use your credit, not debit card, to rent a car. Auto rental companies put large holds on your checking account until you pay your final rental bill, which could tie up your travel funds.
- When sitting down with your luggage, wrap the strap around one ankle to make it harder for a thief to snatch your bag.
- Keep a hotel business card in your wallet. If you're lost and don't speak the language, point to the card so locals can show you the way back.
